

(~ 2 miles north of St. Albert Costco on Hwy 2; please park on RR 253)



Cultivar Specific Agronomy, SeCan Demo and Bayer Demo – AF Cereal Agronomy Research site - NW 36-55-24 W4

From UofA St Albert Research Farm - Head north on Hwy 2 – travel for 2.5 km
Take the exit toward Fort/Saskatchewan (Hwy 37 east) – travel for 9.0 km
Turn left onto AB-28 N (signs for Bon Accord/Cold Lake) – travel for 9.8 km
Turn right onto Excelsior Rd (TwpRd 560) – travel for 3.8 km
AF Cereal Agronomy Research Site is on South side of the road
